C. 20 students were selected to participate in the All County Band Clinic to be held at Southern High School February 16th and 17th. The concert is to be held at Southern @ 7:00p.m. February 17th

D.The Concert Band will be traveling to South Mebane Elementary on March 16th to perform for the students.

E.EHS has put in a bid to host the All County Band Clinic for 2007. (As of February 23rd we have won that bid and the Dates are February 7th & 8th 2007.) Further discussion of this will be held at the next Band Booster meeting.

F.Band Fees are still to be \$175; there was discussion about higher fees for the color guard and per Mr. Bowman, Fundraising was going to play a part in the extra fees. The total amount that is to be paid has not been determined, but could range from \$200-300. A request by Teresa Claiborn was made for help to given by the boosters if any of the students could not pay over and beyond the \$175 fee.

The idea of getting a list of the names of students and past students that have balances in their accounts was made by Phil Poe so we could see if nay of that money could be allocated to help students with their Band Fees.
