Committee Reports

Concessions

Phil was absent but sent word that he needed help for homecoming game concessions. A signup sheet was passed around.

Fundraising

Karen reported that she has Starbuck's coffee for sale. It was decided that the students would not take orders for coffee during the fruit sale. There are 250 bags. More can be ordered. The coffee will be sold at football games. Parents may also check out bags to sell at work.

The Mebane Enterprise will be at the homecoming game at 6:00 to take pictures of the sponsor signs. Karen also said that she has forms for businesses to participate in the discount cards. Walmart sent \$300 and will send \$30 a month after that. McDonald's has been asked to donate fries for the concession stand.

There was no information about the fruit sale. Members asked about the due date and delivery date. Tim will contact the fruit company to set up a delivery date. Money is to be collected at the time the orders are taken. Usually the order is sent in sometime in November, and the fruit is delivered around the second week in December.

There will be a bake sale at the souvenir table on Senior Night, November 2. The money will be designated for the uniform fund. There was also discussion of allocating souvenir money for the uniform fund.

It has been difficult to keep up with souvenirs sold in the concession stand. Workers have tried to keep a tally as they sold the items. Since we know how much we started with, the leftovers can be counted at the end of the season to get an accurate total of how much money was made from souvenirs.

Director's Report

Mr. Bowman was unable to attend the meeting but sent word that he had nothing to discuss. He will be ordering the rest of the clothing paid for by parents by the end of the week.

The band will march in the Burlington parade in November. The Graham parade is December 1st, and the Mebane parade is December 7th. There are three more competitions. The one at Western is October 20th. The band goes to Lee county on the 27th and Graham on November 3rd. Teresa suggested that the band boosters provide something more substantial than snacks at the competitions, such as peanut butter and bread, for those that didn't bring enough money. Concessions at the Raleigh competition were expensive, and some students were hungry later in the day. Dave suggested feeding the band after they finish performing and have changed out of their uniforms. We need to look at the agenda for each competition, but something definitely needs to be done when they go to Sanford. Karen suggested getting donations of food from sponsors.

New Business

Band pictures will be taken on Monday, October 8th during class. Students will bring their uniforms home for the homecoming parade. The bonfire will be over by 9.
